Results & Expertise

Representative Matters

- Represented a client group of ranchers to enforce a judicial water management settlement with a State agency between the clients and the Oregon Water Resources Department. This representation required commencement of a successful contempt action against the State after contested case proceedings, and defense of the clients' win on appeal, obtaining approximately \$190,000 in attorney fees for the clients.
- Represented various water utilities in rate cases before the Oregon Public Utilities Commission, reaching settlement with the PUC in each case to increase rates charged by the utilities to pay for capital expenditures, personnel costs, rent office and storage rent, taxes, benefits, and more, including PUC approval of affiliated interests and utility contracts. Additionally, represented clients to buy and sell rate-regulated water utilities requiring Commission approval.
- Represented various cities in the capacity of City Attorney, representing municipalities on numerous issues including public meetings, public records, public contracting, government ethics, resolutions and ordinances, municipal water and sewer utilities and extraterritorial service, code and ordinance enforcement including zoning, prosecution of misdemeanors, and more.
- Assisted various special districts and private companies with formation in Oregon and California, including petitions to county commissions for public entities, articles of incorporation for private companies, preparation and adoptions of bylaws and rules & regulations, meeting compliance, elections, tax exemption, and more.
- Represented numerous individuals, developers, and a Native American Tribe, to provide large-scale water rights due diligence support for multi-million dollar ranch, farm, and winery acquisitions throughout Oregon and California, including public lands and grazing permit issues on properties managed by the Bureau of Land Management and United States Forest Service.
- Represented numerous clients to negotiate, draft, and record access agreements, including easements, licenses, right of ways, well sharing agreements, and more. Additionally represented various clients in legal actions for judicial declaration of access rights across private properties and public lands held by state and federal governments.
- Assisted clients with removal-fill compliance under the Clean Water Act in wetlands and waterways in order to support maintenance and development of their properties. Additionally defended numerous clients in enforcement actions brought by state and federal agencies, including actions related to removal-fill, fisheries, underground buried containers, hazardous waste, and other environmental compliance issues.

against harmful proposed bills, including written and oral testimony to various legislative committees and outreach to legislators. Additionally served on various state agency rulemaking advisory committees, and submitted comments and protests on behalf of numerous clients challenging proposed government actions and final orders.
